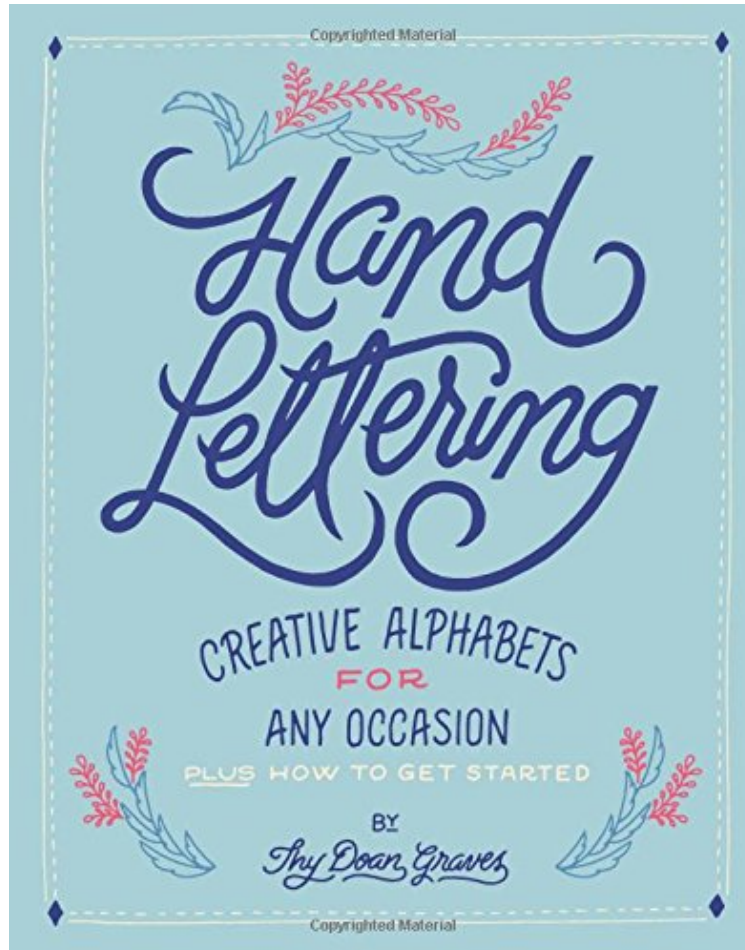

I have used the 'fake' technique with my gel pens and it's gorgeous!
