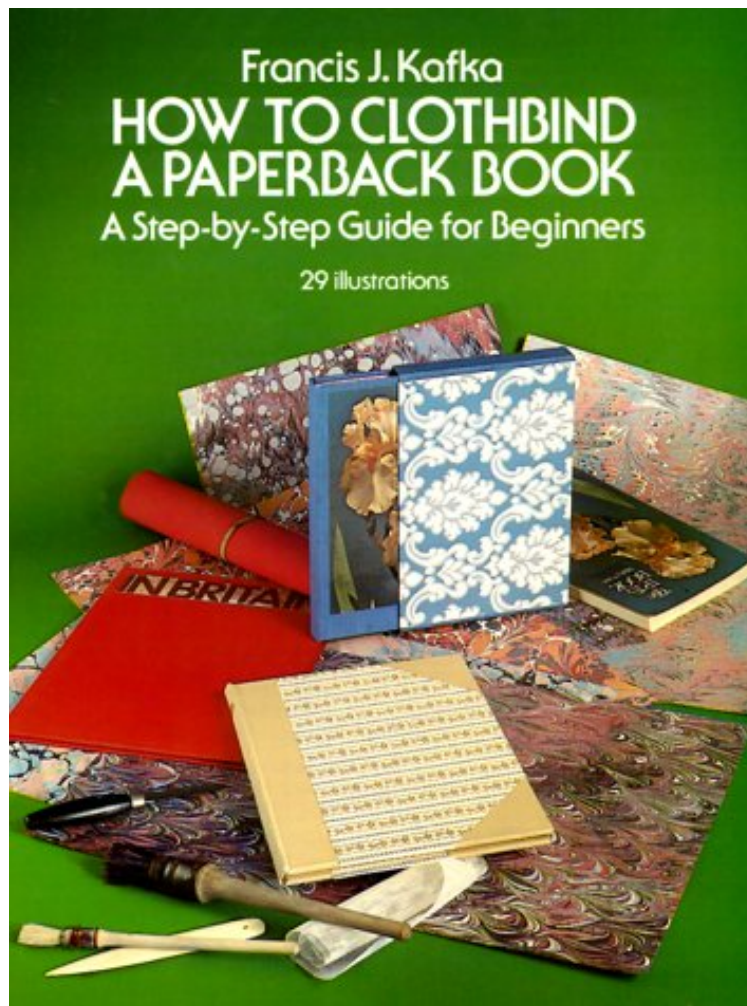

In 2010 I followed the direction to hand bind 54 copies of a fairly simple book and found the process frustrating. The directions were concise and the pictures were few. About half way through the binding process I had to go online to order linen thread from , and was directed to several sites on-line with directions that were easier to follow and many pictures in every stage of the process. I wish I

One of its most useful aspects are the instructions for building basic book-binding tools, a drilling press, a finishing press, and a box mortise. Most other books either try to do without these tools or assume that you have (expensive) professional ones available. I would love to update this book to expand the finishing press to be big enough to accommodate binding 8.5" x 11" materials. Also useful would be some information on sewing individual signatures into a complete book. That would change the title to something like, "How to Clothbind any book."
